Almost every optional extra was included at the time of ordering, also many additional items and features were added to the boat since it was delivered new in June 2021. The boat is named "Ciara Emily" after my daughter and granddaughter. It has been very well looked after since I bought it new, however I didn't manage to sail it as much as I would have liked. This was mainly due to age related health issues which is not overly surprising for a 76 year old. For this reason, I have now very reluctantly decided to sell my beautiful boat to somebody who is physically more able to enjoy it fully. The boat is currently winterised at my home in Wexford town in Ireland where it can be viewed by prior arrangement.

The Bayraider Exhibition sailing yachts are a pleasing blend of modern technology and traditional looks. They are designed and built to a very high standard in the UK by the pioneering yacht manufacturer Swallow Yachts. The superior hull design, the modern carbon fibre masts, the Bermudan yawl rig, the NACA centreboard and rudder foils on this craft ensures enhanced performance on the water. While sailing performance is very important the designer (Matt Newland) also managed to retain the boats traditional classic lines, which certainly adds to the boats charm and appeal. In the cabin there are comfortable cushions with sufficient room for two tall adults to stretch out, and with the addition of an optional cockpit tent, you could sleep up to four adults. The unique design of the water ballasted system on this boat helps to ensure its excellent stability and sea keeping qualities on the water. Also having the ability to remove the water ballast while on the water is a great advantage. In a recent review by Practical Boat Magazine the boat was described as follows;

“Unballasted she is a lively performer, rewarding and exciting to sail, and is capable of planing off the wind. Filling the ballast tank the Bayraider Expedition is at once more docile and very seaworthy, instilling confidence in all who sail her.”

The ability to remove the water ballast on this boat also ensures ease of handling when taking the boat in and out of the water and while towing her on the road. More information on this type of boat can be found using the following links;

The recently installed electrical system on the boat was designed to support an automatic Bilge Pump, a Garmin Chart Plotter and a Raymarine Depth Instrument. The main battery system on the boat is maintained and kept fully charged by means of a Solar Panel and a MPPT charge controller.
