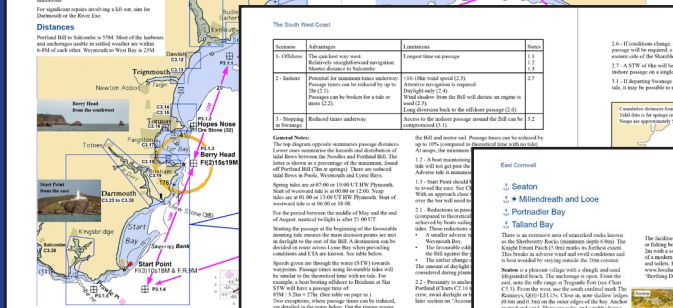
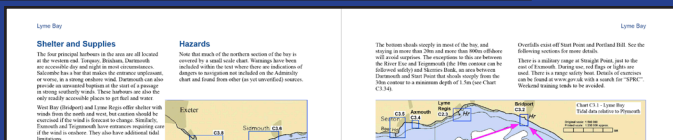

Southwest Passage Plans

This hardback book covers the area from Christchurch to the Isles of Scilly.

It aims to provide a reference to create passage and cruising plans before departure and find alternative options if weather conditions change.

The harbours and many of the anchorages along this coastline are also covered. Admiralty Chart extracts are used in combination with text and photographs to enable a safe approach and entry. Where possible, these are contained to a single spread within the book, allowing it to be readily accessible and "hands-free".
